

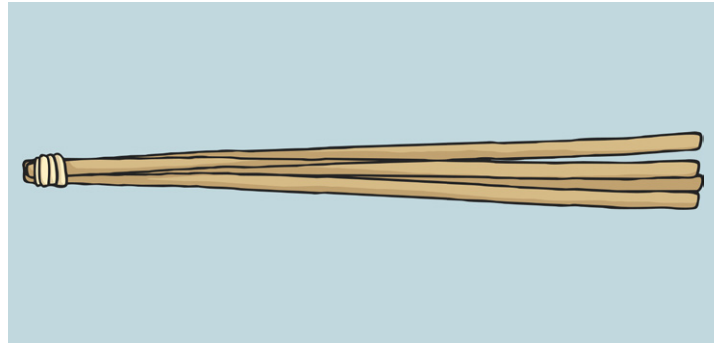
# Making a Fish Lantern



## Stage 1: Creating Your Structure

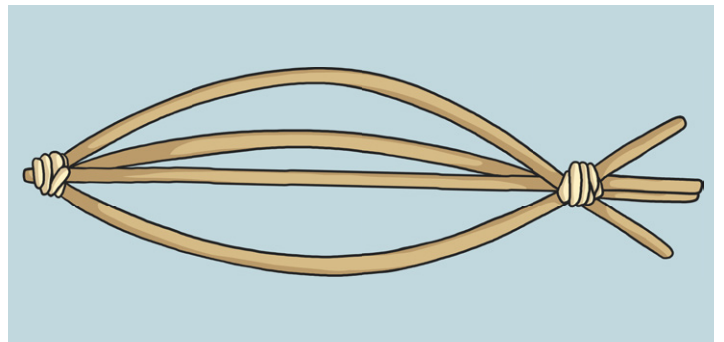
### Step 1

Bind the end of 4 withies with tape. Secure this really well!



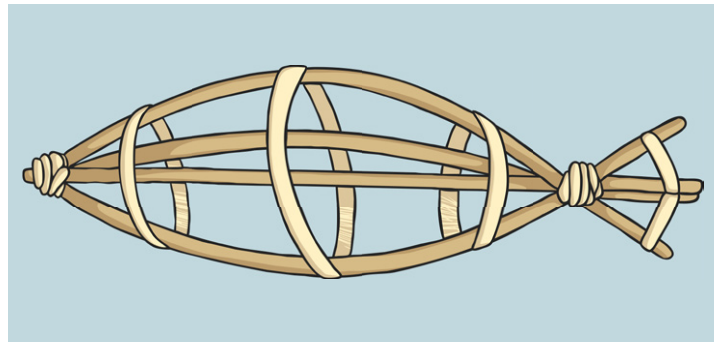
### Step 2

You will need a partner to help you with this step. Use one of the withies as a central point to tape the other withies to. Hold the bound end of one of the withies and push the other end so that it forms an arc. Fix the bent withy into place with tape around the central stick. Do this for each withy.



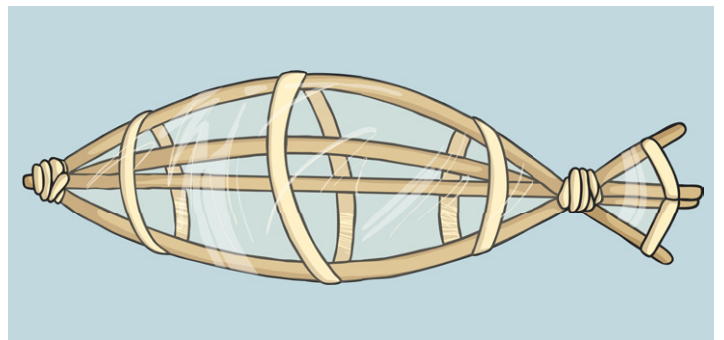
### Step 3

Check both ends of the fish to make sure they are taped up properly! Add masking tape across the fish.

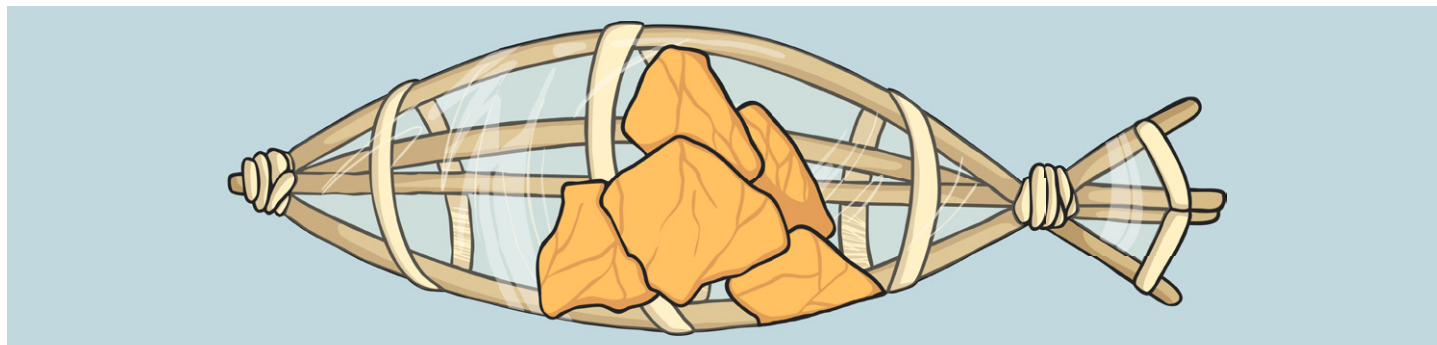


### Step 4

Once everything is secure and taped, add a cling film layer on top. Secure with tape where needed.



## Stage 2: Covering Your Structure



### Step 1

Tear small squares of your tissue paper. These need to be about 5cm square.

### Step 2

Paste a patch of glue onto your cling film covered model and stick a square of tissue paper onto the patch. Paste over this patch with more of your glue solution. This makes sure that the square is stuck firmly and also gives it a glossy finish once dried.

### Step 3

Keep sticking on squares until your structure is fully covered.

### Step 4

Once your lantern has dried, you will need to make a hole big enough to insert your light. Carefully use scissors to cut the hole and push your light inside.

### Step 5

Your lantern is finished! Why not have a parade to show off your work?
