#### FROM THE HEADTEACHER

This week has been an incredibly busy week for all of the staff. On Monday we hosted three other Headteachers from local schools who came in as part of a Peer Review process. This uses local expertise in helping school leaders to review the practise in their schools. We are working with four other schools and I will be leading a review in one of the other schools later on this term. The Headteachers came in to review the work we have been doing with the children on developing the use of language for learning and the way we encourage children to extend their vocabulary. These colleagues went into classrooms and asked children and teachers about the learning. It was pleasing to have the reassurance that we are all working well together and the children are using the language structures to help them solve maths problems.

On Tuesday, the children in Years 1 - 3 went to the seaside. This was a rescheduled trip that had originally been planned for the end of last term, but was postponed due to Covid-19.

We also had a review on Wednesday where our Hertfordshire Improvement Partner looked at our provision for reading from the Early Years and up through the school. The reading is going very well and so many parents are supporting their children by reading regularly. Please do continue to do this.


