On Thursday, as well as World Book Day, we had a visit from Mrs Anne Gorolini who is our Hertfordshire Improvement Partner. Her role is to come



Revd Debbie writes:

Before moving to Sawbridgeworth, my husband and I used to live in London just around the corner from the Ukrainian Cathedral – the place which Boris Johnson visited earlier this week. We passed it by most days on our way to and from work, and on the way to church every Sunday when we would see crowds of cheerful people greeting friends and family on their way to worship. We even had the pleasure of meeting members of the congregation when we were given a grand tour of the beautiful cathedral during an open



day.

Oh how sad, worried and mournful they must be now as they watch the destruction of their homeland on their TV screens, and how proud they must be of the people of Ukraine and of the Ukrainian President

Volodymyr Zelensky. Addressing the European Parliament the other day, he told members of the EU: "Nobody is going to break us. We are Ukrainian."



There was a sight I used to look forward to witnessing every year on Easter Day outside the Ukrainian Cathedral: joyful women and children carrying brightly adorned baskets full of beautifully painted Easter Eggs and traditional food. My hope is that, as soon as this Easter, they may joyfully gather once again, in the knowledge that peace has prevailed in their homeland.

In the meantime, my thoughts and prayers are with the people of Ukraine.


