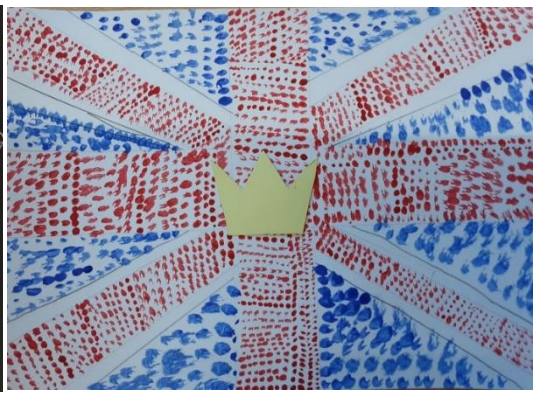


Sapphire Class have been working on their computers, creating their own pictures using the pointilism technique that was originally developed in 1886, as a branch of Impressionism.

Revd Debbie writes:

This week, we came to the end of our current collective worship theme of 'service'. In his collective worship on Monday, Fr Simon, looking forward to today's Platinum Jubilee school party, explored the way in which The Queen has been a wonderful example of service.



Meanwhile, I've been reflecting on the way we can all serve each other in prayer, sparing a thought for all those we know and love, and those we don't necessarily know and who may even live far and wide.

Last week I attended the funeral of an old school friend, Marcia. Marcia had no close relatives, but she did belong to a tight-knit church family. And during the last weeks of her life, they cared for her physically but, just as importantly, they cared for her spiritually. They prayed for her and with her, and told how, in her final prayers, Marcia, who throughout her life had unselfishly put others first, had continued to make others her priority in prayer.

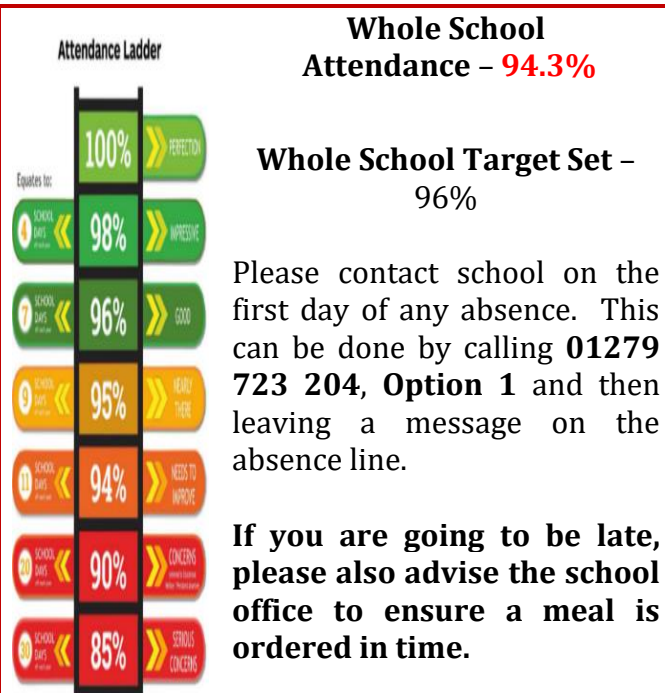
