I have been delighted to see some excellent writing from Diamond class this week, with a lot of the class writing at a very high standard in terms of the vocabulary used, and their ability to create description.

I have also seen Emerald class demonstrating their memory of a key text and their ability to recall it using symbols as prompts. What was particularly pleasing, was seeing how much they enjoyed showing what they could do and how clearly they all felt pride in their work.

The teachers and I have spent time during our Inset Day and this week's staff meeting looking at our curriculum design and making changes and additions so that our teaching has progression and continuity throughout the school from EYFS to Year 6 and meets the needs of all of our learners in all of the subjects. We are very mindful that we want all of the children to develop a very strong understanding of the core skills of Maths and English, but also that the curriculum is motivating and broad so that different talents and abilities are fostered.

We have also been thinking ahead and planning events so that Christmas is celebrated and enjoyed in school. We will let you know more, nearer the time.
