Dear Parents and Carers,

My week started with a lovely service at Great St Mary's on Sunday, where Father Simon Vivian was welcomed as the new Vicar. He later joined us on Wednesday for his first meeting with us as a member of our governing body. He will be part of our Harvest Service in about a week's time and we will send out information about that next week.

It seems that we have now established the 'new normal' and the bubbles and procedures around the school are working effectively. The children in all classes are getting on well and making progress in their learning.

This week, we tried accessing a remote lesson from the PSHE providers, Coran Life, who usually come in to do the 'life tent'. This time, the trainer - Nancy appeared on the boards in the classroom and led the lessons on well-being remotely. We are one of the first schools to do this with this provider and I am pleased it went so well. The new whiteboards that we recently purchased are already proving their worth.

Today, we had the elections for Head Boy and Head Girl, which would usually involve the candidates giving speeches to the whole school in the hall. As that is not an option, we broadcast their speeches from Diamond Class to the other classes so that the whole school could participate and vote. I am delighted to announce that the Head Boy is Rocco G and the Head Girl is Mia. Thank you to all of the children who put themselves forward for this responsible position. Next week we will continue this process and vote the sports leaders in.

Thank you for helping with the after school arrangements by staying with your vehicles. It feels so much safer if we avoid people walking around near moving vehicles. It is also very helpful to us that the children see that adults are modelling social distancing.

We continue to review our risk assessments and contingency plans in the light of the regular updates and I hope you have received updated information from us this week. Please could you remember that parents should only come into the school building following a prior arrangement and specific appointment.

### Nasal Flu Vaccine on Friday 13th November


