## FROM THE HEADTEACHER

After a great summer break, we are delighted to back in school and eager to commence the new school year. The teachers came back to work last Friday and spent two days training. One day focused on safeguarding and child protection, ensuring that all are fully aware of the latest guidance and procedures. The other day was a very practical day and put the staff into the role of being the learners. This term we shall be introducing a new element to our curriculum, which will fit into parts of PE, PSHE and outdoor learning and aims to promote character development. In order to understand the programme, the staff were required to take part in a number of activities and challenges. As a great deal of this involves problem solving and working as a team, that is what the staff were required to do. We had fun even as we learned and reflected on all the benefits the children can gain from this. It is called Commando Joe's and will be rolled out across the school, starting this term.




Our youngest children have started their phased transition into school. It is going very well, and all seem to be coping. They are enjoying having fun together and getting to know each other as well as getting used to all of the daily routines. (see above)

Sapphire Class have been enjoying the weather outside and using their new play equipment. We are hoping that their new climbing equipment will have the surface completed at the start of next week and be available for use before the end of the week. They have also started their more formal curriculum and I will enjoy teaching some of Sapphire class, currently the Year 1s, for maths every Friday.



Emerald have started their science topic on rocks and have been comparing and grouping together different kinds of rocks based on their appearance. Over time they will learn more about the different types of rocks and how they are formed. They will also continue to develop their observational and descriptive skills.



Diamond Class are starting their first history topic of the year, WW2, and have created these Blitz skylines using a colourwash and black silhouettes.



Next week there will be meet the teacher sessions after school for Sapphire, Emerald and Diamond Classes. Even if you know the teachers well, this meeting is a good opportunity to find out more about the expectations for the year for your child's class and we would therefore love to see you all. We will arrange some supervision for children so that you can focus on the information from the teacher.


