#### FROM THE HEADTEACHER

#### **School Council Shoebox Collection**

Our School Councillors organised the 'Operation Christmas Child' shoeboxes collection this year. A list of recommended items was sent out to families and included ideas like, "include a toy that a child will immediately love as soon as they open the box." The shoeboxes came into school and the School Councillors packed and wrapped them.

#### **Ruby Class Early Literacy Skills**







Ruby class have daily phonics where they learn the sounds and put them together in green words (ones they will read in their books).

To build on this the children are encouraged to use the sounds and to write during their child-initiated play and learning time.

Practicing saying the sounds with a friend is a great way to reinforce their learning and practising writing letters very carefully is a vital foundation for writing fluently as they progress through the school.

#### Sapphire Class learning about Judaism

In Sapphire Class, the children have been learning about Judaism. In Judaism, helping those in need is a commandment, a sacred obligation.



The Hebrew word for giving to those in need is "Tzedakah" but it doesn't just mean charity. A Tzedakah box is not for saving money like a piggy bank, but for giving money to help other people.

In a Jewish family it is a mitzvah (religious duty) to give tzedakah every Shabbat to help other people. Some people give money, but they can give anything that will help others.



The children all made a Tzedakah box and wanted to take them home to fill up with loose coins and donate to charity (completely optional!)

#### **Tag Rugby**

Children from Diamond Class walked along to Leventhorpe on Thursday afternoon to take part in a tag rugby event. It was led by the Year 10 sports leaders, who did a superb job of organising the event and taking the children through warm up activities at the beginning.

Four primary schools took part and we played each of the other schools. Our team scored lots of tries. They enjoyed it despite the freezing cold. Well done to them.





#### Pick up at the end of the day and safety in the carpark

At the end of the day, some parents are blocking the drive-through by parking up in inappropriate places. I am very concerned about the safety implications of this for the children and anyone getting over to a vehicle.

One of the causes, is a reluctance to park in the bays in the car park. Another is the lack of bays, which is why we open the playground.

We do not open the playground gates until 3:00 for safeguarding reasons and to ensure a secure site whilst children are still involved in activities on the field and MUGA, therefore a large number of parents arriving before 3:00 pm causes problems.

Please do your best to time your arrival so that you are not here before 3:00 pm. Diamond Class do not come out until 3:20, therefore those parents have a little more time.




