Advent: We are gearing up for Christmas. This week in Collective Worship we thought about Advent and how Christians use this time to prepare for the coming of Christ. Some classes have their own advent calendars, some

are having fun with Elves and even Fred the Frog instead.



Diamond Class have a different twist on the traditional advent calendar and have a BookVent. Each day the children discover a new book under the tree. They are keen to see what it is and whether they recognise the author and are eager to be the first to take that book and read it. One child came into school the following day having read an entire book in an evening.

We are practising Christmas Carols and Ruby and Sapphire Class are learning their lines and songs and getting their costumes ready for the nativity that will be performed for

parents next week. Some were trying their costumes on when they added a decoration to the tree so I have had a chance to see how super they look.
