Knowledge and Understanding – Look at the Ships Powerpoint . Discuss the different types of boats and ships. Compare sizes, shapes and uses. Have you been on a boat or ship? What kind was it? How did it move? What is your favourite type? Where could you go?	Design and Technology- Handmade boats. You could make these from the top of washing up liquid bottles or other small plastic containers, with a blob of play dough or plasticine inside, and a straw with some triangles of different coloured paper attached or by folding paper. Use the bath or water tray to have a boat race. Extension- Write an evaluation on what your boat was like and what would make it better.	Music- Learn Rhyme of the Week- Row, Row, Row Your Boat song. Think of some more actions and props to add to your performance. Perform in your pirate ship.	Maths- Play the 'Hot and Cold Treasure Game' One family member is 'It' and leaves the room or play area. The other member decides where to hide a special object or 'Treasure' .When 'It' returns, the hider says "hotter" or "colder" as it gets closer or farther from the treasure until it is located. See who can find the chosen item fastest.
