can go and play with them.



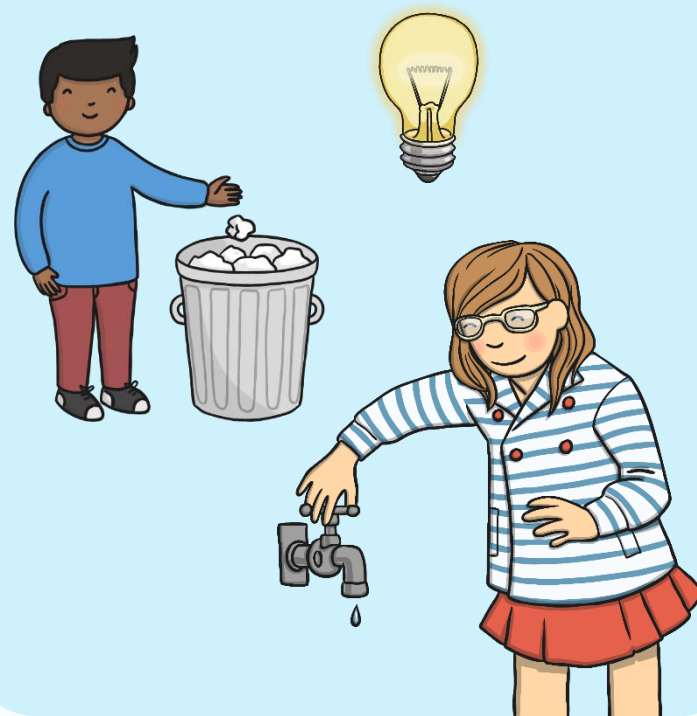
When someone is stuck with

We should look after the environment and the world too!



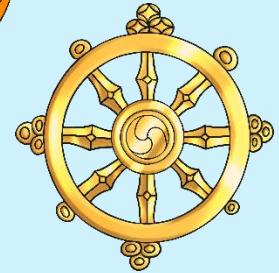
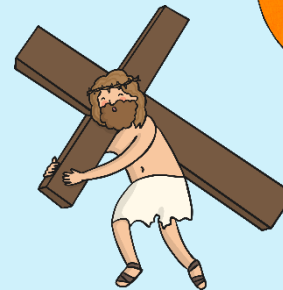
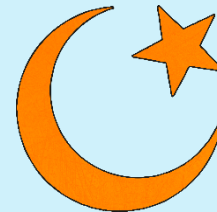
Different Religions
